The 2024 show is being held on the weekend of October 25-27. PSSA is excited to announce that they will have the Pennsylvania Off Highway Vehicle Association partnering with us this year! Show hours are Friday: 5-9 p.m.; Saturday: 10 a.m. – 6 p.m.; Sunday: 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

The MapGears Trail application sponsored by PSSA is up and running. Currently all of the trails in state forests, in state parks, and in the Allegheny National Forest are loaded and available in the application. Additional club trails will be added as they are provided to PSSA. This program is the same one used by New York and several other states. There are two parts to this application. The first part is a website which anyone can log into for viewing trails and printing off a map. The second part is a phone app that you can purchase for \$4.99 which will show you where you are on the trail.
