Membership Information

Your membership application for the upcoming season is enclosed. Please note several important changes:

- We will no longer offer additional club stickers beyond the membership allotment of **2 stickers for Single Memberships** and **4 stickers for Family Memberships**.
- If all of your snowmobiles are registered to the same name and address, no additional stickers are necessary.
- Paper trail maps will no longer be provided.

Instead, members are encouraged to use the **RidePA app**, which includes snowmobile trails throughout Pennsylvania and provides trail status updates indicating whether trails are open or closed. The RidePA app is available through your device's app store or via the PSSA website. The upgraded version costs **\$4.99** and is highly recommended for the additional features included.
